

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Who can enter the Walyalup I Fremantle Arts Centre Print Award 2025?

The award is open to all artists living and working within Australia, aged 16 or older as of June 1, 2023.

2. How many artworks can I submit?

Each artist is invited to submit only one artwork for the competition.

3. What are the requirements for the artwork?

The artwork must be created using any printing process and must be the submitting artist's original work, completed no earlier than June 1, 2023. Works in multiple parts are acceptable, but they must be considered as a single artwork.

4. How should I submit my entry?

Entries must be submitted online through the official submission portal. Emailed submissions will not be accepted. You will be required to upload up to five digital images of your artwork in JPEG format. Each image should be labeled with your surname, first name, and image number (e.g., Surname_FirstName_1).

5. What is the entry fee?

The entry fee is \$50.00 (inc. GST), and it is non-refundable.

6. What do I need to submit along with my images?

Along with your images, you must submit a short biography (100 words max) and a description of your artwork (150 words max). Do not include any other materials with your submission.

7. What is the deadline for submissions?

The deadline for submissions is 5pm AWST on Monday, June 2, 2025.

8. How will the artworks be selected?

A panel of industry professionals will judge all entries. You will be notified whether your work has been selected by Monday, June 23, 2025.

9. If selected, when must I deliver my artwork?

Selected works must be delivered to Walyalup I Fremantle Arts Centre by 5pm on Monday, July 14, 2025. The work must be received in full and on time to be eligible for exhibition and prize selection.

10. Who covers the cost of freight for the artwork?

Artists are responsible for the cost of shipping their artwork to the Fremantle Arts Centre. Fremantle Arts Centre is responsible for freighting the work back to artists. Any extraordinary freighting requirements will also be covered by the artist.

11. Is my artwork insured during the exhibition?

Yes, all selected artworks will be fully insured while in the keeping of the Fremantle Arts Centre until Tuesday, October 21, 2025. The Centre will also cover the cost of returning unsold works.

12. Can I sell my artwork?

Yes, all exhibited works must be available for acquisition. A 35% commission (plus GST) will apply to all sold works.

13. Will my artwork be used for publicity?

Yes, images of selected artworks will be used for promotional purposes, including on the Fremantle Arts Centre website, social media, and in marketing materials. All selected artists will be asked for permission to use these images for up to five years.

14. When will the winners be announced?

The winners will be announced at the opening of the exhibition on Friday, August 15, 2025.

15. When does the exhibition close?

The exhibition will close at 5pm on Sunday, September 21, 2025.

16. How do I make my payment?

The entry fee is paid online via the eWAY payment system. You will be redirected to the payment page after completing your submission form.

17. Can I withdraw my submission after entering?

Once submitted, entries are non-refundable, and the entry fee cannot be refunded.

18. What if I live locally, can I collect my artwork in person?

Yes, local entrants may collect their unsold artwork from the Fremantle Arts Centre after the exhibition closes, but all works must be claimed by Tuesday, October 21, 2025.
