AND HIS CREATIVE SELF

City of Fremantle Art Collection presents a retrospective exhibition about Fremantle artist Theo Koning (1950–2022) who is recognised for his inventive creativity, and over five decades fostered an irrepressible commitment to artmaking. Koning's instinctive collecting, making and material sensibilities delivered unpretentious artworks that moved between sculpture, assemblage, installation, painting, performance, film and poetry. He used found objects and materials with equal sensitivity and poise. His oeuvre is acknowledged for its enigmatic blend of marine and domestic motifs and mischievous humour, delivered through an attention to contrasting materials that carry a social critique and political dimension. Koning exhibited on twenty three occasions at Walyalup Fremantle Arts Centre after 1973.

He was the recipient of numerous art awards and commissions, including the Mark Howlett Foundation Commission in 2003, and was appointed the Perth Festival artist and won the inaugural Mandorla Art Award in 1985. In 2015, he was awarded the prestigious Artsource Basel Atelier Mondial Residency. He is widely represented in state and national collections in Australia, including and notably in the City of Fremantle Art Collection.
